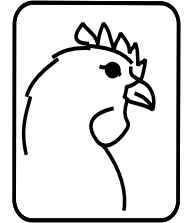


# DOZURIL<sup>®</sup> 25 mg/ml

## Characteristics:

- » Solution for use in drinking water
- » Target species: pullets and breeders
- » Administration: orally, via drinking water
- » Dosage: 7 mg per kg of bodyweight per day during 2 days, this corresponds to 28 ml of oral solution per 100 kg of bodyweight per day
- » Withdrawal period: Meat and offal 16 days
- » Available in 1 litre bottle

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# DOZURIL® 25 mg/ml

## NAME AND COMPOSITION:

Dozuril 25 mg/ml solution for use in drinking water for chickens

### Per ml:

Toltrazuril 25.0 mg

## TARGET ANIMALS:

Chickens ( pullets and breeders)

## INDICATIONS:

Treatment of coccidiosis in pullets and broiler breeders.

## CONTRAINDICATIONS:

None

## AMOUNTS TO BE ADMINISTERED AND ADMINISTRATION ROUTE:

Administration: orally, via the drinking water.

Dosage: 7 mg per kg of bodyweight per day for 2 consecutive days, orally, this corresponds to 28 ml of oral solution per 100 kg of bodyweight per day or 1.4 ml of the product per litre of drinking water, based on a water consumption of 1 litre per 5 kg of bodyweight.

This medicinal product should be administered either continuously over 48 hours, or for one 8 hour period per day for 2 consecutive days.

## WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

Meat and offal: 16 days

Eggs: Not authorized for use in laying birds producing eggs for human consumption.

## SPECIAL STORAGE CONDITIONS:

Shelf-life of the veterinary medicinal product as packaged for sale: 4 years.

Shelf-life after first opening the immediate packaging: 3 months.

Shelf-life after dilution according to directions: 24 hours.

This veterinary medicinal product does not require any special storage conditions.

## PACKAGING:

1 Liter bottle

Supply on veterinary prescription
